



An integration programme is made up of:

- a Dutch language course;
- classes about life in Belgium. Here you will learn about living and working, education, your rights and duties and a lot more besides. You can take the classes in your own native language or in another language you understand;
- coaching in your efforts to find a job or a suitable training course;
- information about sports, culture and leisure.

Your work and family situation are taken into consideration. The integration programme is free.

Who is it for?

You qualify for an integration programme if you:

- are a foreigner or a Belgian born elsewhere
- live in Flanders or in Brussels
- are 18 years of age or above.

What about your child?

We help you find a school for your child.

You can speak to a personal counselor with any questions you may have. He speaks your language or another language you understand.
